What can I expect from the donation process?

Donating your placenta and umbilical cord is one of the easiest ways to make an impact on the health of others in your community. By donating this birth tissue, you can join the 95% of Americans that support donation.¹

Your placenta and umbilical cord may help as many as 75 people.²



It's as simple as providing the necessary consent and answering a confidential questionnaire related to your medical and social history. These questions are similar to those asked of blood donors. There is no cost to you or your family for any part of this donation.

Donation is safe.

This donation will take place after the safe delivery of your infant. It will not affect the delivery or the care you and your baby will receive.



Donation is painless.

We will coordinate the donation process in conjunction with your routine pre-natal care and testing.

How to Donate

This is the most important day of your life. The quality of care and the safe delivery of your baby is our highest priority.

A Sharing Miracles team member will coordinate your donation, guiding you through:

- Giving informed consent
- Completion of a medical history questionnaire (20-25min)
- Providing for access to your prenatal, delivery, and infant records

Mothers having traditional births or C-sections can give the priceless gift of birth tissue.

After you complete the paperwork, our team will coordinate the rest of the process with your provider and hospital or birth center. A Sharing Miracles representative will be on-site the day you deliver to manage the handling and transport of your birth tissue.

The review of your medical record is strictly confidential. Information and documents are accessed only by trained, authorized personnel working in a secure environment.

To ensure the safety of birth tissue for recipients, your blood will be tested for infections that could transmit disease. Abnormal results will be reported to you and your provider.

How does your birth tissue help those in need?

Biological properties in the placenta and umbilical cord help to promote regenerative healing.³ Grafts made from your birth tissue can help reduce inflammation and scarring while promoting a healing environment. These grafts can be used to facilitate the healing of patients with a wide range of conditions, including neurotrophic keratitis, corneal scars, dry eye, diabetic foot ulcers, osteoarthritis, and chronic and non-healing wounds, to name a few.

The placenta and umbilical cord are typically discarded as waste, but for patients in need it's a second chance at life.
